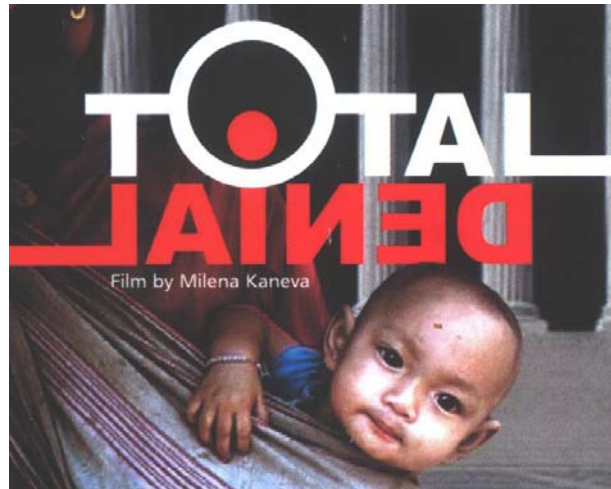


Film Show: "Total Denial" in Burma

Do you know Burma? An Asian country nearby? Or the pro-democracy leader and Nobel Peace laureate Aung San Suu Kyi?

Burma had been a British colony since late 19th century. Since its independence in 1948, Burmese people have been leading a poor life. Civil wars, suppress from corrupted government and other serious violations of human rights are just some cases in point demonstrating how devastated Burmese people are.



Total Denial - is a dramatic and moving documentary which chronicles the personal and political journeys of the groundbreaking human rights lawsuit brought by both EarthRights International and villagers from Burma against oil giant Unocal and Total. This film is directed by the winner of the 2006 Vaclav Havel Human Rights Award - *Milena Kaneva*.
