How to get to Kowloon Union Church



1. If you are taking the subway, go to the Jordan MTR Station.
Exit from the station using the Exit B2

2. If you are taking the taxi, tell the driver to take you to the junction of Cox Road and Jordan Road.
The entrance to KUC is located 30m from the junction at No.4, Jordan Road, Kowloon.
